
# Site Plan and Sketch Design Fact Sheet

# What is a site plan and sketch design?

Both the **site plan** and **sketch design** must be specific to the project and are mandatory requirements for the funding application.

A <u>site plan</u> shows the location or positioning of the new infrastructure relative to the site boundaries and potentially existing infrastructure at the site. For example, the site plan below. A Google Earth image may also be used, but will require additional information transposed to provide further detail.






A <u>sketch design</u> should enable any reasonable person to clearly understand what the organisation plans to construct/develop and include the dimensions and main features of the project. A sketch design can also include elevations, sections, perspective (artist impression) to make a more complete sketch design.


### **IMPORTANT**
