Waste Reduction and Recycling Act 2011

DECLARATION OF EXEMPT WASTE-WASTE DONATED TO A RECOGNISED RELIGIOUS ORGANISATION CONDUCTING A CHARITABLE RECYCLING ACTIVITY

This declaration is made under section 35 of the *Waste Reduction and Recycling Act 2011* by the Director of the Office of Resource Recovery, Department of Environment and Science, for and on behalf of the Director-General, Department of Environment and Science.

Under this declaration, waste that has been donated to a *recognised religious organisation* but that cannot practically be re-used, recycled or sold is declared to be exempt waste subject to any conditions and limitations (as per section 35(3) of the Act) included in this declaration.

For the purpose of this declaration, a recognised religious organisation is an organisation that-

- a) is affiliated with a recognised denomination declared under the Marriage (Recognised Denominations) Proclamation 2018, and
- b) fulfils the requirement of a charity under section 5 of the Collections Act 1966.

The following conditions and limitations apply to this declaration—

- a) an organisation seeking to operate under this declaration must request and obtain approval from the department¹
- b) in requesting approval the organisation must provide:
 - I. information demonstrating the organisation:
 - i. meets the definition of recognised religious organisation; and
 - ii. meets those parts of the definition of *charitable recycling entity* under sections 28(5)(a), 28(5)(c), 28(5)(d) of the Act
 - II. other information as required in the approved form 'Approval of waste as exempt waste—charitable recycling entity', other than information relevant to section 28(5)(b) of the Act.
- c) If a request under this declaration is approved and a Certificate of Exempt Waste issued, it must be presented each time the exempt waste is delivered to a waste disposal facility.
- d) The waste under this declaration is exempt from 1 July 2022 to 30 June 2025.
- e) A Certificate of Exempt Waste issued under this declaration may be cancelled or amended for any of the reasons outlined in section 34 of the Act.

This declaration of exempt waste is made on the date of publication on the department's website.

¹ A request for approval will be considered along the lines of an exempt waste application made under section 28 of the Act.
