

**DISASTER MANAGEMENT WASTE - DECLARATION OF LIMITS
STATE OF QUEENSLAND**

As Director of the Office of Resource Recovery, Department of Environment and Science (the Department), and delegate to the chief executive of the Department, pursuant to section 27 of the *Waste Reduction and Recycling Act 2011* (the Act), I declare limits apply to disaster management waste in relation to the disaster situation declared by the Premier and Minister for Trade and the Minister for Fire and Emergency Services for the whole State of Queensland by gazettal in the Queensland Government Gazette volume 383 No. 57 on 22nd March 2020 pursuant to section 69 of the *Disaster Management Act 2003* (the 'COVID-19 disaster situation').

At the date of making this declaration, I declare that disaster management waste in relation to the above disaster situation is subject to the following limit:

- a) no waste is disaster management waste.

Should there be any changes to this declaration, including its conditions, a new declaration will be made.

Definitions

Waste Reduction and Recycling Act 2011

"disaster management waste" means waste generated by or because of a disaster that is or has been the subject of a declaration of a disaster situation under the *Disaster Management Act 2003* but only within the limits, if any, declared by the chief executive, by publication on the department's website, for a particular disaster.

This declaration is made on the date of publication on the department's website.
