	This form should be first completed by an independent and experienced Queensland lawyer before being signed by a prospective home owner.

This form must be used if a prospective home owner wishes to reduce the precontractual disclosure periods under sections 29 and sections 48A of the *Manufactured Homes (Residential Parks) Act 2003* from the default notice period to at least 7 days from receiving the documents from the park owner.

This form confirms that a prospective home owner has received legal advice from an independent and experienced Queensland lawyer about entering into the site agreement or accepting an assignment of an interest in the site agreement. A copy of this form must be:

- signed by the prospective home owner and the Queensland lawyer who provided the advice; and
- given to the park owner.

Important information for the prospective home owner	 It is very important to understand your rights and obligations before signing a site agreement or accepting an assignment of an interest in a site agreement. This form confirms that you have received legal advice about the site agreement or proposed assignment. The Queensland Law Society can help you find a qualified lawyer with expertise in manufactured home site agreements.
Important information for the park owner	A park owner must not enter into a site agreement with a person, or consent to the assignment of an interest in a site agreement, unless they have been given the necessary precontractual disclosure documents within the required
	timeframes. Penalties and an extended cooling-off period apply if a park owner does not comply with these requirements.
