SUMMARY OF AMENDMENTS	
Section changed	Details of change
Section 7 – Letter of compliance	This requirement has been amended to reflect legislative changes made in the <i>Integrity and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2024</i> for relevant independent offices and the tabling of their annual report.
Section 13.4 – Public sector ethics	This requirement has been amended to include further guidance for reporting in compliance with sections 12K and 12L of the <i>Public Sector Ethics Act 1994</i> .
Section 14.5 – Information systems and records management	This requirement has been amended with minor wording update to records management (previously recordkeeping) and other minor clarifications.
Section 17 – Financial statements	This requirement has been updated to clarify the requirement for the inclusion of financial statements within the body of the annual report, and not as an appendix.
Section 20 – Queensland Government Brand and Visual Identity	The requirement has been amended to reflect the Queensland Government Brand and Visual Identity requirements (Brand book).
Section 22.1 – Tabling of annual reports	The minimum tabling requirements have been updated to request documents not be bound with plastic cover sheets and to be printed double-sided.
Section 31.3 – Queensland Language Services Policy (QLSP)	This requirement has been amended to clarify naming convention requirements when publishing to Open Data.
