

**DECLARATION OF EXEMPT WASTE IN EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES – RAIN AND FLOODING
EVENT WASTE FROM LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA LOCKYER VALLEY REGIONAL COUNCIL**

This declaration is made under section 35 of the *Waste Reduction and Recycling Act 2011* (the Act) by the Director, Waste Avoidance and Recovery Services, Department of Environment and Science as delegate for the chief executive.

Under this declaration, I declare waste generated to be disaster exempt waste subject to any conditions and limitation (as per section 35(3) of the Act) included in this declaration.

The following conditions and limitations apply to this declaration–

- a) For the purposes of this declaration, disaster exempt waste means waste generated in the Lockyer Valley local government area by or because of rain and flooding event that occurred in May 2022.
- b) Waste is exempt waste only for the period 12 May 2022 up to and including 17 August 2022.
- c) Waste is exempt waste only if it disposed of at the following waste disposal sites:
 - i. Gatton Landfill
Fords Road, GATTON QLD 4343
 - ii. Laidley Waste Disposal Facility
Burgess Road, LAIDLEY HEIGHTS QLD 4341
 - iii. Toowoomba Waste Management Centre (Bedford Street)
155-175 Hermitage Road, TOOWOOMBA QLD 4350
 - iv. Remondis Australia Pty Ltd -Remondis – Swanbank Landfill
End of Swanbank Road, Swanbank QLD 4306
- d) Waste disposal site operators and/or person delivering waste must ensure the exemption code issued is recorded or presented each time the disaster exempt waste is delivered to the waste disposal facility.
- e) Waste Disposal Sites nominated to receive disaster exempt waste may continue to charge fees for the delivery of waste.

This declaration of disaster exempt waste is made on the date of publication on the department's website.
