Heatstroke is when your body cannot cool down.


You might:

fast




Have a fast

Protect yourself

Extreme hot weather can be dangerous

You should:




Drink water

Every 15–20 minutes while working.



Check urine colour

It should be pale or light yellow.




Wear sun protection

Light clothing, hat, SPF 30+ sunscreen, sunglasses.



Rest and cool down

Take breaks under shade and cool off with wet towels or a shower.




Work in cooler hours

If possible, work in early morning or late afternoon.



Keep medicine and food safe

Store in a cool, dry place, away from sunlight.
