Information on this form, and any attachments, is being collected to process and assess your application under section 134 of the Stock Route Management Act 2002. Both local and State agencies must comply with the information privacy principles in the Information Privacy Act 2009. This means your personal information will only be accessed by authorised personnel to manage and issue your permit and to manage the stock roues, roads and reserves. This may require some information to be shared with other relevant local or state agencies e.g. Department of Agriculture and Fisheries for biosecurity or animal welfare reason (tracking of animals), as well as holders of permits and authorities along the permitted route of travel so they can be advised of your travel. Your personal information will not otherwise be disclosed by the department unless authorised or required by law.
