Funding to help clubs grow

## Fact Sheet

### What is *Get Going Clubs*?

*Get Going Clubs* supports sport and active recreation at the grassroots level.

*Get Going Clubs* provides funding to local and regional sport and active recreation organisations to improve their capabilities to better deliver activities in Queensland communities.

### What funding is available?

Eligible not-for-profit sport and active recreation organisations can apply for funding of up to \$7,500 (GST exclusive).

### What projects are eligible?

Eligible projects are those that improve club capabilities to:

- provide quality sport and recreation activities
- improve access to sport and recreation opportunities
- deliver new opportunities to engage in sport and recreation.

An organisation can request funding for one project with any combination of the following components, up to a maximum of \$7,500 (GST exclusive):

- education and training
- equipment
- participation.

### Who can apply?

Organisations eligible to apply are:

- Queensland local not-for-profit sport and recreation organisations and not-for-profit local community organisations (with an objective of sport or active recreation) incorporated under the:
  - *Associations Incorporation Act 1981* (Qld)
  - *Corporations Act 2001* (Cwlth)
  - *Cooperatives Act 1997* (Qld)
  - *Corporations (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander) Act 2006* (Cwlth)
- an incorporated sport or recreation club formed within a Queensland university.

Organisations must also have met all obligations for projects currently funded by the department.

Organisations approved for *Get Going Clubs* Round 6 funding in 2017 (project delivery period of 1 January 2018 – 31 December 2018) are NOT eligible for Round 7 of the program (exceptions apply – further details in the guidelines).

The Sport and Recreation Grant Registration Portal must be used to apply. You must register in the portal if you wish to apply for funding. It is recommended that you register as soon as possible to be able to start an application.
